N this issue of IEEE TRANSACTIONS ON EDUCATION, I am very pleased to enclose, in CD-ROM form, the first two issues of a new IEEE publication, the *Revista Iberoamericana de Tecnologías del Aprendizaje / Revista Iberoamericana de Tecnologías de Aprendizagem* (IEEE-RITA), a Latin-American Learning Technologies Journal. This CD-ROM includes the complete first two issues of IEEE-RITA (volume 1, number 1 and volume 2, number 1) comprising 11 articles, ten of which are in Spanish and one in Portuguese, and four editorials. I look forward to expanding our partnerships with other international groups focused on engineering education.

IEEE-RITA, a publication of the IEEE Education Society, is focused on the Iberoamerican community (Latin America, Spain, and Portugal). It addresses not only this geographical community, but also extends to the worldwide Spanish-Portuguese speaking community. IEEE-RITA was approved by the Administrative Committee of the IEEE Education Society in its meeting of June 19, 2006, as a pilot project to demonstrate new ways of providing information and knowledge to non-English readers and also to collect data on potential reader interest. The approval of IEEE-RITA by the IEEE Technical Activities Board and the IEEE Publication, Services, and Products Board is pending. Upon formal IEEE approval, IEEE-RITA will be published quarterly (February, May, August, and November). During its initial, pilot phase, two issues will be published annually, in May and November. The publication of IEEE-RITA is supported by the Spanish Ministry of Education and Science through complementary action TSI2005-24068-E. To give some summary statistics, the first issue had 4,759 hits on the Web server, with 1,759 article downloads. The second issue had 2,974 hits on the Web server, with 616 article downloads (over the summer period only).

As we publish these issues of IEEE-RITA in IEEE TRANSACTIONS ON EDUCATION, the Call for Articles is open for the 2008 IEEE-RITA issues. IEEE-RITA publishes papers in Spanish and Portuguese, and welcomes all interested authors and readers.
